PCPA seeks to match with interns who are excited about primary care, are flexible, and have strong clinical and assessment skills. In order to qualify for the internship, all applicants must demonstrate that they will complete the following before the first day of the internship: 1) matriculated in an APA-accredited academic training program, 2) At least 800 hours of supervised practicum experience (Masters-level practicum experience counts toward these hours, as well as experience not yet completed at the time of application); 3) The 800 hours is divided between assessment and intervention practicum training, 4) Individual supervision must be amply provided during these practicum experiences 5) Successful completion of all doctoral coursework.
